Introduction:

Outline the history of Lye and Wollescote Cemetery and Chapel.

Main Task/s: Either -

- Use information from the **History** section of this site to **write a story/biography** based on the life of one the people in the cemetery and/or:

- Write a War Report about one of the World War 1 soldier

Write a newspaper/website article based on the Coombs Wood mining accident of 1929
Write a diary entry as a World War 1 soldier
