Alice Perks: Died 28th June 1928 aged 69

In 1896, seven years before the Suffrage Movement begain under Mrs Pankhurst, twenty-two years before women had the vote and twenty-three years before the first woman became a Member of Parliament, Alice Perks met with Lye Parish Council and gave the names of twelve women to be member of the council. This was quite a brave and daring act at this time.

Research Questions: 1. Look at the 1911 census return for Alice Perks. What was her address? 2. Can you find this address on a current map? Can you find the address on an historic map dating from around that year? 3. Who was Mrs Pankhurst and what was she campaigning for? 4. In what year did ALL women finally get the vote?
