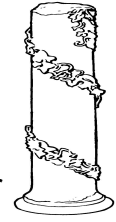

Going on a Tree Hunt!



There are many trees growing in the cemetery. They are very important for wildlife. Can you think why that is?

Can you identify 4 common trees found in the cemetery from the clues and draw their leaves in the correct boxes. Be careful – try not to pick leaves off the tree or touch any berries, they may be harmful to you. Look on the ground for other clues to help you.

Clues	Your drawing
<p>The Monkey Puzzle Tree (<i>araucaria araucana</i>): A tall evergreen tree with thick, tough and scaly leaves. It's branches and leaves are said to look like monkeys tails!</p>	
<p>The Holly Tree (<i>ilex</i>): A tree with glossy leaves and red berries. Often seen at Christmas time. Spiky and sharp leaves – watch out!</p>	
<p>The Horse Chestnut Tree: (<i>aesculus hippocastanum</i>) Sometimes called the conker tree, a large tree with droopy leaves.</p>	
<p>The Weeping Willow Tree (<i>salix chrysomcoma</i>): a tree with droopy leaves and branches. You may say it looks rather sad, hence it's name.</p>
